

ORDINANCE NO. 665-1

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 665 OF SHASTA COUNTY ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA
ADOPTING PUBLIC FACILITY FEES FOR ALL NEW DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE COUNTY
OF SHASTA," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 15
SUSPENDING THE JULY 1, 2020 ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. A new Section 15 is hereby added to Ordinance No. 665 to read as follows:

The annual adjustment of impact fees stated in Section 8 of this Ordinance to be imposed effective July 1, 2020, is hereby suspended. Said suspension will remain in effect until such time as the Board of Supervisors, by resolution, lifts the suspension. The suspended adjustment shall then be imposed effective the date of said resolution. The annual adjustment in Section 8 of this Ordinance for July 1, 2021, and years thereafter, shall continue as set forth in this ordinance. This section shall be made operative retroactive to July 1, 2020.


SECTION 2. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. The adoption of this ordinance shall not in any manner affect any action or prosecution for violation of ordinances, which violations were committed prior to the effective date hereof, be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, or penalty required by or resulting from any such ordinance, or affect the validity of any bond (or cash deposit in lieu thereof) required to be posted, filed, or deposited pursuant to such ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage. The Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published as required by law.


