**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA  
REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2023-017 AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY  
FOR THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS RELATING TO  
FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FOR  
DISASTERS, AND THE CALIFORNIA DISASTER ASSISTANCE ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Shasta, acting as the Shasta County Operational Area under the California Emergency Services Act (Gov. Code, §8550 et seq.), may periodically apply for Emergency Management Performance Grant Program funding and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance for Disasters from the United States Department of Homeland Security, sub-granted through the State of California and administered by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal-OES), and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act; and

**WHEREAS**, Cal-OES requires jurisdictions that apply for Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) funding, Public Assistance (PA) for Disasters, and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA) to designate authorized agents who may execute applications and documents for the purpose of obtaining such financial assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, the designation of authorized agents for FEMA PA and CDAA funding is permitted to be designated for a period not exceeding three years, as long as the resolution is renewed before the three-year period expires; and

**WHEREAS**, this allows the County of Shasta to continue applying for funding without needing to re-designate agents every time a new disaster declaration is made within the three-year timeframe.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta, acting as the Shasta County Operational Area, that the positions of Shasta County Sheriff, Shasta County Fire Chief, Shasta County Executive Officer, or their designee, and Shasta County Director of Public Works, are hereby designated as authorized agents and the individuals occupying those positions are hereby authorized to execute for, and on behalf of, the County of Shasta, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining Public Assistance for Disasters provided by the United States Department of Homeland Security and sub-awarded through the State of California, and/or any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta are making this designation effective for three years from the date of approval; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Resolution No. 2023-017 is hereby repealed.

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
