### **RECOMMENDATION**

Approve a renewal agreement with the Anderson Union High School District to provide educational services for inmates at the Shasta County Jail in an amount not to exceed \$290,000 for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027.

### **DISCUSSION**

This renewal agreement with the Anderson Union High School District (District) will allow the District to continue to provide a Partnership Learning Center Program (Program) in the Jail with adult education components to provide educational opportunities leading to high school graduation or California High School Equivalency (GED) certificates. Additionally, should the agreement generate Average Daily Attendance (ADA) revenues that exceed the cost of the Program (staff costs and District administrative costs), the excess ADA revenues will be deposited into the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund which helps to fund the cost of the Program.

### **ALTERNATIVES**

The Board could choose not to approve the agreement; however, ADA funding would not be available to help offset the Program costs, leaving the Inmate Welfare Fund as the sole source of funds for these services.

### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT**

County Counsel has approved the agreement as to form. Risk Management has approved the agreement. The Recommendation has been reviewed by the County Administrative Office.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This agreement will have no impact on the County General Fund or Public Safety Fund. In accordance with California Penal Code Section 4026, the Shasta County Inmate Welfare Fund finances the cost of these services, primarily through commissary purchases made by inmates and telephone commissions.
