### **RECOMMENDATION**

### **DISCUSSION**

Formed in 2021, the Shasta Substance Use Coalition is comprised of more than 25 local agencies and organizations working together to combat harmful substance use in Shasta County. The Coalition aligns strategies to increase community awareness and understanding of substance use disorder, works to increase opportunities to engage individuals in treatment, promotes timely access to evidence-based treatments, enhances access to recovery support services, and reduces harmful substance use and overdose related deaths. The Coalition provides an ongoing forum and resource hub for the integration of substance use related work in Shasta County. Monitoring substance related data trends, the Coalition facilitates planning and coordinates resources to improve outcomes.
